

FACT SHEET EKTROPY II

CONTRACTS MODULE

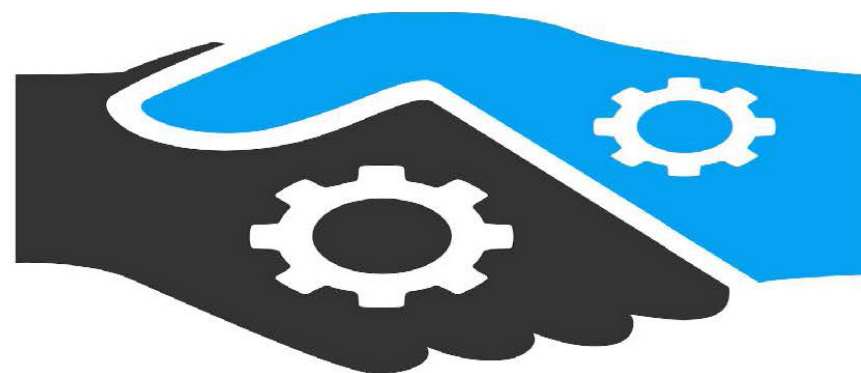


The Contracts Module is part of Ektropy II, an information technology (IT) tool. It captures information on all contracts within the Defense Health Agency Enterprise including its Headquarter activities, Markets, Military Treatment Facilities and other related activities.

The Contracts module was developed to track requirements over time across multiple contract awards and to support rationalization efforts. It is tied to the Spend Plan and Personnel modules within the Ektropy II system. This allows the Contracts module to display what is being procured and who has been hired to provide services. The contract module provides a centralized repository which allows for standardization, rationalization and consolidation of contracted requirements.

Background:

Ektropy II is an IT tool used across the Defense Health Agency Information Operations (J-6) Directorate to support program and portfolio management. The solution provides insight into personnel, programs, costs and contracts across all activities. It improves management of cross program dependencies and reduces the IT manpower footprint.
