The Health.mil website is the organizational web presence for the Military Health System (MHS) and the Defense Health Agency (DHA). In addition to providing a vehicle for official MHS and DHA news and information, Health.mil provides the central content management system (CMS) for MHS and DHA business and internal web sites.

The centralized Health.mil CMS enables operational and sustainment control for MHS and DHA websites, facilitating more efficient site management and overall cost reductions. Websites under Health.mil include the Hearing Center of Excellence, Vision Center of Excellence and Army Medicine beneficiary sites. Additionally, the Transparency Initiative Group access and quality metrics are maintained on Health.mil. The Web & Mobile Technology Program Management Office, a component of the DHA Solution Delivery Division, is responsible for planning and executing the consolidation initiative along with operational sustainment and maintenance support of Health.mil sites.
