FACT SHEET JDES JOINT DISABILITY EVALUATION SYSTEM

JDES is an information technology solution used by the armed services to increase transparency of the Disability Evaluation

System process.

JDES provides case management, tracking, reporting and electronic information sharing capabilities while increasing visibility of DES procedures for processors, command teams and uniformed service members.

Service members engage in one of three disability evaluation processes: The Legacy Disability Evaluation System, the Integrated Disability Evaluation System or the Expedited Disability Evaluation System. The goal of the Department of Defense in cases of separation or retirement resulting from a disability, is to ensure continuity of care, timely processing, and seamless transition of service members to the Department of Veterans Affairs.

In the future, JDES will interface directly with the VA's Veterans Benefits Management System.
