MHS GENESIS THEATER provides Role 3 operational medicine sites with a robust electronic health record solution for management and documentation of patient care.



## WHAT IS MHS GENESIS THEATER?

MHSG-T is the theater configuration of MHS GENESIS, Department of Defense's name for the federal electronic health record. MHSG-T supports theater hospitals, forward resuscitative sites, hospital ships, naval surface ships, and submarines. It replaces legacy operational medicine health record components.

MHSG-T allows providers to document clinical and dental care while operating independently in disconnected, intermittent, and low-bandwidth environments. When operating in a comms-enabled environment, MHSG-T supports patient care data exchange through the Operational Medicine Data Service which feeds data from the point of injury to MHS GENESIS at military treatment facilities.

In addition to providing a robust and modernized EHR, MHSG-T can also scale to fit changes in facility conversion of R ole 4 MTFs into Role 3 care facilities in military contingency planning.
