What is an Anomalous Health Incident?
AHI is the term used to describe a series of unexplained and sudden symptoms associated with the acute onset of a sensory event, such as pressure, heat, loud sounds, or other auditory phenomena.

For TRICARE® Patients

- ✓ Seek urgent medical care
- ✓ Report the AHI event to your unit and DOD counterintelligence agents
- ✓ Notify your primary care manager of a possible AHI event
- ✓ If appropriate, your provider will refer you to the NICoE for AHI medical care

For Non-TRICARE Patients

- ✓ Seek urgent medical care
- ✓ Report the AHI event to your counterintelligence representative
- ✓ Contact your agency for a DOD AHI Approval for Care Memo
- ✓ Once the memo is approved by the DOD, you will be referred to the NICoE for AHI medical care
