

Department of Defense Suicide Event Report (DODSER) FACT SHEET

DODSER standardizes suicide surveillance across the armed services to support the military's suicide prevention mission.

DODSER tracks a variety of suicide-related risks and factors. Authorized users must document all suicide deaths, incidents identified as suicide attempts or other suicide-related behaviors, such as intentional self-harm and suicidal ideation, in DODSER.

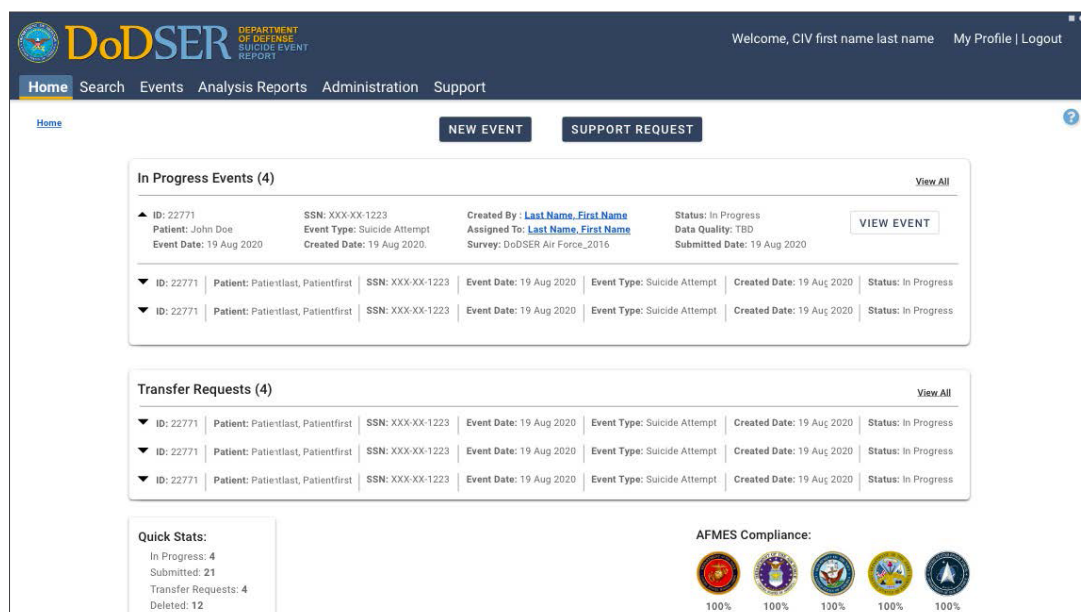
