SUBJECT: National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2009 Permanent  
Prohibition Against Requiring Certain Injured Members to Pay for Meals  
Provided by Military Treatment Facilities

Section 602 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2009 makes permanent the requirement that military treatment facilities provide meals at no cost to members of the Armed Forces receiving inpatient or outpatient services for an injury, illness, or disease incurred in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom, Operating Enduring Freedom, or any other operation or area designated by the Secretary of Defense as a combat operation, or in an area designated as a combat zone. Health care services include medical recuperation or therapy, or other continuous care.
