


- Polypharmacy Medication Analysis & Report Tool (Poly-MART) was designed to support OTSG Policy 15-039.
- This tool has been designed to identify enrolled members to MTF installations for direct care.
- Utilizing this method of populating member information is dependent on current enrollment information, which can be controlled at MTF enrollment locations.
- Medication prescription history is current for the given month where the TRICARE pharmaceutical benefit was utilized; including MTF, Mail Order, & Retail Network Data. The ER data is current on a rolling 12 month time frame.
- Data is captured from the PDTS data warehouse and M2 data repository.

Cohort Design



•The POD/PASS added a cohort numbering convention to correspond with specific circles and overlapping areas. The reports within the tool use the numbered cohorts terminology to identify the circle or area where members fall.



This form will allow the user to import an alpha roster to assist in the filtering of data in the Polypharmacy MART. Users should be aware of possible discrepencies between the data loaded in the MART and service members on thier current rosters. Because data is pulled and grouped by the most recent PCM DMIS ID attached to the service member in PDTS at the time of the report creation, it is possible that service members will show up in this tool that will not be in the alpha roster loaded.
To ensure an alpha roster will be loaded, the alpha roster must be loaded into the Excel template provided by the POC.




