This session will highlight how carbon fiber dynamic orthoses (CDOs) are now a mainstay of care after severe lower limb trauma. They can be an essential component of efforts to restore a functional gait pattern and successful return to daily activities. Recent scientific evidence challenges long-held assumptions about how ankle foot orthoses (AFOs) work and the effects they have on gait. This session will provide insight into the role of care pathways and orthosis design on a range of outcomes in military and civilian settings.
