Assessment of Dizziness & Visual Disturbances Following Concussion ▶

July 2 and Nov. 5

This training provides medical staff with a single, comprehensive reference for the assessment and management of dizziness and visual disturbances following mild TBI. Dizziness and vision problems often present with overlapping symptoms and should prompt a provider to perform an assessment. • 1 CE/CME hour

Management of Headache Following Concussion: Guidance for Non-Primary Care Managers ▶

June 4 and Oct. 2

This training reviews the 2024 revision of the Management of Headache Following Concussion/Mild TBI: Guidance for Non-Primary Care Manager clinical recommendation. Attendees will learn about non-pharmacologic and pharmacologic intervention of post-traumatic headache and medication overuse headache. • 1 CE/CME hour

Management of Sleep Disturbances Following Concussion ▶

This training dives into the Neuroimaging Following Concussion clinical recommendation, a concise and interactive clinical algorithm with guidance on imaging modalities in the acute and post-acute time frames.
