Dear Mr. Chairman:

This letter responds to Senate Report 111-295 accompanying S. 3800, Defense Appropriations Bill, 2011, dated September 16, 2010 which requested a report on the timeline for changing the Department of Veterans Affairs/Department of Defense (VA/DoD) Joint Executive Council (JEC) Strategic Plan (JSP), to explicitly discuss the Departments' electronic health record (EHR) system modernization efforts and how those efforts will cost effectively address common requirements of DoD and VA. As this issue falls within the purview of the Under Secretary of Defense for Personnel and Readiness, I have been asked to respond. Similar letters are being provided to the other House and Senate committees of interest.

The JSP is a means to advance interagency collaboration between VA and DoD. It is annually evaluated, updated, and improved. As the Senate Appropriations Committee noted at the time of their request, the fiscal year (FY) 2010-2012 JSP (published in March 2010) did not state the Departments' emerging plans for achieving common EHR requirements. DoD and VA have since committed to implementing an integrated EHR (iEHR). The iEHR will ultimately provide the next generation EHR for both Departments. The Virtual Lifetime Electronic Record health initiative (VLER Health), which leverages the Nationwide Health Information Network, will support the Departments' common requirement to exchange healthcare information with each other, other Federal agencies, and private sector healthcare partners.

- 9. DoD and VA will:
  - a. Develop Concept of Operations for VCA 3 by March 31, 2012.
  - b. Identify via the BEC IS/IT Requirements Working Group (RWG) meetings and/or RWG Subgroup meetings the specific longitudinal electronic health and administrative (benefits/personnel) data needed for housing, education, insurance, and memorial benefits by July 31, 2012.
  - c. Develop implementation strategy for VCA 3 foundational capability by July 31, 2012.
  - d. Develop Performance Evaluation Plan for VCA 3 in accordance with BEC IS/IT guidance by September 30, 2012
  - e. Begin to capture VCA 3 lessons learned and incorporate into subsequent implementations by September 30, 2012.

#### VCA 4

- 10. VA will enhance the Memorial Affairs Performance and Usability Enhancements (MAPUE) capability to allow Veterans and their dependents to pre-apply for burial and memorial benefits before the time of need via the eBenefits.gov portal by September 30, 2012
- 11. DoD and VA will develop VCA 4 Performance Evaluation Plan by December 31, 2012.
- 12. DoD and VA will Identify requirements for VCA 4 capabilities in collaboration with VA, SSA, and other federal/private partners by December 2012.

#### Recommended Metric(s)

Metrics will be developed by December 31, 2012 which will address the following performance areas:

- Efficiency of electronic information sharing for disability claims adjudication and benefits provision processes
- Timeliness of electronic information sharing across DoD and VA for benefits adjudication
- Accessibility of electronic information for benefits adjudication
- Capability enhancement (e.g., data elements shared, auto-population capability)
- User satisfaction
